Community Improvements

Planned wood repair and touchup painting is complete on East. Minor warranty related paint fixes are occurring on Buildings 10-20 and other touchups on Buildings 20-32.

Utility boxes located on the side of buildings were replaced and painted. They look great!

As a result of additional paint touchups, mailboxes will be addressed next spring.

Repairs were completed for multiple, severely washed-out beaches to better handle the water overflow in heavy rains.

Several large, badly damaged grass areas were reseeded.

The south entrance island is expected to be completed by the end of this month.
