# **Capital Planning Meeting Held**

Once again, thanks to those of you that attended the Capital Planning meeting earlier this month. See the email sent on 6/5 with the full presentation that included estimates for future Supplemental Assessments.

As a reminder, the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the 2025 Supplemental Assessment is \$2500 and is due by August 1<sup>st</sup>.

# **Major Projects – Looking Good!**

BHP maintenance vendors got off to a slow start with all of the rain this spring but are all now running at full speed.

Over 500 arborvitaes were planted and mulched. Please water any near your unit a couple times a week for the next couple of months so they all get off to a healthy start. Thanks!

A list of trees and bushes that need replacement was created following a spring walkthrough. As the budget permits, replacements will be installed in the next few weeks.

A third round of landscape refreshes are planned later this summer for a couple of visible islands to improve the entry into the complex.

The water levels are good!

Wood repair is almost done on BHP West and painting is in progress. Later in the summer, there will be additional wood repair planned for Bldgs. 1-9 since they did not get that in the early painting phase. Paint touchup will then be required.

By the end of this week, all docks will have been power washed and stained. It's good to get rid of the patchwork of wood colors around the lake!

Finally, a major cleanup was completed on the Pavilion beach. It looks fresh and clean!

#### **Normal Maintenance**

There have been four (4) different applications of fertilization and pest/grub control applied to the grass, trees and boxwoods, all in an effort to improve the health of our extensive landscape investment. Spring weeding is complete.

Tree and bush trimming starts THIS WEEK! If you don't want newly landscaped bushes trimmed, stake the protected areas.









# Kindly Reminders....

Children under 6 years of age must wear a USCG-approved Type I or II PFD when riding on a boat.

All vessels must be equipped with a PFD for *each* person.

Dogs must be kept on a leash and any waste must be picked up immediately.

Parking pads are to be used for visitors and are not for homeowners on a regular basis. Fines will be given to frequent offenders.

Please don't feed the waterfowl!

For those homeowners that were notified of the need to stain or repair wood rot on decks, a remediation plan is due by July 7<sup>th</sup>.
